## The Winstanley Scholarship Proforma

The Winstanley Scholarship, usually £500-£1000, is awarded to assist in research by way of travel, for subsidizing the cost of publishing the results of research, to enable students to gain experience in suitable offices overseas, or for any other purpose which the Selection Committee may approve.

It is awarded in ODD years ie 2003 is the year.

Applicants must have been born in Lancashire. The MSA are prepared to interpret the definition of Lancashire to include areas formerly within the county.

Recipients of the award will be required to illustrate the results of their studies to members of the Society by lecture presentation or exhibition during the MSA Events Week, or through the publication of an article in a professional journal.
